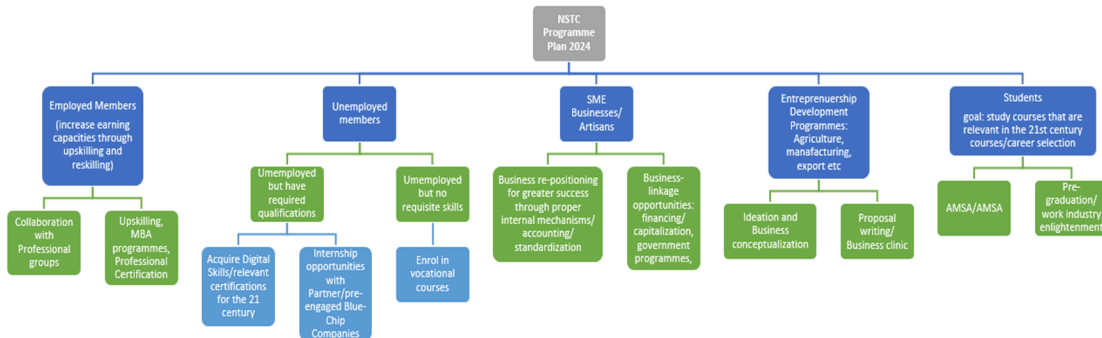
Report of the National Sanato-Tijarat Team: January 2024

The National Sanato-Tijarat team implemented the following programmes in January 2024:

1. The development of 5 programme areas and setting up management teams for each programme cluster

The NST team developed 5 key programme areas to address

Terms of Reference for Each Cluster:

1. Employed Ahmadis Cluster

- A. Draw up and implement regular enlightenment programmes to enable employed members to upskill and take new certification courses.
- B. Organize dedicated programmes to promote soft skills development that would make the members more valuable in their respective organizations, thus enhancing their capacity to be promoted regularly and earn more.
- C. Develop programmes that promote the career progression and material growth of employed members
- D. Track progress and performance of members on the set programmes
- E. Collaborate with professional bodies already established within the Jamaat towards developing sector -specific career advancement programmes (eg AMLA, IAAAE, etc)
- F. Carry out other tasks and programmes as may be approved from time to time, by the NSTC Chairman

2. Unemployed Ahmadis

2 (i): Unemployed members with requisite qualification, eg B.Sc.

- A. Organize dedicated programmes to promote soft skills development that would make the members better prepared for the work industry.
- B. Organize mock interviews and other programmes to aid members' preparation and selection at the next job opportunities
- C. Create industry linkage opportunity to increase job chances for Jamaat members
- D. Create internship opportunities (with or without pay) for members to enable them work in pre-engaged Blue-chip companies across the telecoms, FMCG, Oil and Gas, banking, Agriculture, etc. This will enable the members to gain requisite experience, and possibly be retained or seek employment with other companies.
- E. Develop linkage with government-led/government-approved vocational centers
- F. Organize regular training programmes to encourage Unemployed members to learn new digital skills or take up skills at the vocational centres across Nigeria.
- G. Upon programme completion, implement programmes that will guide unemployed members on income-earning activities based on their newly-acquired skills.
- H. Members can also join the employed category through gainful employment or the SME Business/Artisan team.
- I. Track progress and performance of members on the set programmes
- J. Carry out other tasks and programmes as may be approved by the NSTC Chairman

3. SME Businesses & Artisans

- A. Provide a 'Business clinic' to review Ahmadi businesses and indicate improvement areas
- B. Organize regular programmes towards promoting the standardization of Ahmadi businesses
- C. Organize training sessions to enlighten Ahmadi Business owners on business standardization processes
- D. Support these businesses towards achieving process standardization through business registration/CAC, proper accounting operations, business management courses, etc
- E. Develop business linkage opportunities for these businesses to increase their operating capital
- F. Partner with non-interest based financing organizations to increase lending opportunities for Ahmadi businesses.

- G. Track progress and performance of members on the set programmes
- H. Carry out other tasks and programmes as may be approved from time to time, by the NSTC Chairman

4. Entrepreneur and Business Development

- A. Develop structured training programmes to educate members on ways to generate Halal Businesses Ideas and opportunities
- B. Enlighten members on Business Conceptualization and ways to turn social problems to business opportunities
- C. Guide members on end-to-end Business proposal writing and presentation
- D. Train members on presentation skills to facilitate deep engagements of business proposals
- E. Create linkage opportunities for members to turn the newly-developed business ideas to venture capitalists/financing opportunities.
- F. Track progress and performance of members on the set programmes

5. Students and Career Path

- A. Conduct regular sessions (online) to interact with Ahmadi students secondary schools on course selection and career choice.
- B. Organize sessions with Ahmadi students in different tertiary institutions to encourage students to put in the best efforts in their studies
- C. Organize quarterly enlightenment sessions for graduating Ahmadi students on expectations in the working environment and ways to secure well-paying jobs.
- D. Train students on public speaking and presentation skills to build their confidence and prepare them for tasks ahead
- E. Link the graduating students with the Entrepreneurship Skills Development unit for onward engagements on job creation focus.
- F. Track progress and performance of members on the set programmes
