Report of the National Sanato-Tijarat Team: Sept 2025

Below is the National Sanato-Tijarat team report for the month:

1. Financing of business:

- Funding of approved businesses in Lokoja, Ipaja-Ayobo, Ilorin, Auchi, Ijebu-Central, Remi and Oke-Ogun Circuits. There has been a consistent monthly repayment by the applicants funded so far.
- Total approved loans, so far: N7,500,000
- Total repayment so far: N1,480,000
- Had a virtual session with the President of Nigerian Ahmadis in the UK to discuss collaboration on the different Sanato-Tijarat initiatives in Nigeria
- 2. **Annual work plan**: Held a Seminar titled *Agro-Entrepreneurship Opportunities for Youth and Retirees* on September 27, 2025. The panelists delivered step-by-step playbooks on crop production, agro-processing, goat and fish farming, poultry processing, and accessing government support. The session was in collaboration with the Zira'at office.
- 3. As part of the next steps to connect members with the experts/panelists on each of the business focus areas, 7 clusters were created by the Zira'at office: Poultry, Goat rearing and livestock, agro financing, crop plantation, setting up a Major agro project, etc

4. **NST Programme initiatives**

- **North-South Foodstuff Purchase plan**: The programme took off successfully with 40 bags purchased from Maiduguri and transferred to Ibadan. Project logistics support were provided by a Jamaat member that was shortlisted in Kano Circuit. A dedicated group was also created to manage the orders and delivery to the member-buyer locations in Lagos, Abeokuta, Ota and Ibadan
- **Business applications**: So far, 88 applications were received from different Circuits across Nigeria. The team is working with internal stakeholders and co-guarantors to aid the approval.
- **Qard Hassan applications**: So far, 22 applications received. The first sets of applications have been processed.
- **Online Business Directory**: This initiative was established to showcase verified businesses owned by Nigerian Ahmadis on the Sanato-Tijarat online directory, with the aim of increasing visibility and patronage for the businesses. So far, a total of 124 businesses have completed the onboarding form
